Village	A village is usually associated with the countryside and is smaller than a town.
Significant	Something or someone very important.
Heritage	The history and traditions of a particular area or culture that are significant today.
Rural	It is a place in the countryside that is not as busy as urban places.
Living memory	A time that can be remembered by people who are still alive.
Beyond living memory	Events that happened a long time ago and cannot be remembered by people who are alive today.
War Memorial	 <p>A monument to commemorate those who died or were injured in a war.</p>
Blue Plaque	<p>A round blue sign attached to a building to commemorate its historical significance.</p> 
Well Dressing	A tradition in some rural parts of England where people decorate wells with pictures made from natural things.
