## SCHOOL UNIFORM

In order to promote a sense of belonging to the school, to reduce competition and to promote good behaviour we expect children to wear our school uniform.

- BOYS:** Black or grey trousers  
White, navy or pale blue shirt or polo shirt  
Navy sweatshirt with/without school logo  
Black/dark shoes, trainers or flat boots (not white/bright/flashing lights)  
If trainers are worn for school pupils **MUST** bring a separate pair for outdoor PE
- GIRLS:** Black, grey or navy skirt or trousers  
Navy pinafore dress  
White, navy or pale blue shirt or polo shirt  
Navy sweatshirt or cardigan with/without school logo  
Black/dark shoes, trainers or flat boots (not white/bright/flashing lights)  
Blue summer dresses during the summer  
If trainers are worn for school pupils **MUST** bring a separate pair for outdoor PE

Please avoid extremes of skirt length, high heels, backless shoes and football strips. School uniform with the school logo on can be purchased at <https://myclothing.com/whitwell-primary-school/5554.school>, or if you prefer to buy jumpers/cardigans elsewhere there are badges available at school to sew onto the garments. Badges cost £2.20 each.

**P.E.** The children need a PE and games kit. This should consist of plimsolls, white top and black or navy shorts (for indoor PE) plus trainers or football boots and jogging suits for outdoor games. Football strips are not allowed for PE.

From September 2021, we would like children to continue to come to school in their P.E. kits on their P.E. days. For outdoor P.E. children will need to come in black or blue joggers/leggings and a white/blue plain t-shirt and jumper/cardigan or plain track suit top with outdoor trainers. When doing field sports in KS2, children will be told to bring a spare pair of shoes. For indoor P.E. children will need black or blue shorts and a white/blue plain t-shirt with plimsolls or indoor trainers. Children may come with joggers over the top of shorts or bring their shorts to put on later. Please note that branded sportswear, football kits or clothes with logos or picture are not suitable - thank you!

**Jewellery** - No jewellery is allowed in school except watches and studs in pierced ears.

In accordance with Local Authority regulations, all items of jewellery, including studs in pierced ears, must be removed for PE, games and swimming for obvious safety reasons. If ear studs cannot be easily removed then the child will be asked to cover them or not take part. For this reason if you are considering having your child's ears pierced please try and time this for the beginning of the six week holiday so that they are healed to enable removal once back at school.
